63rd Annual Meeting of Spanish Fort Water System Board Held on March 2, 2026

Call to Order at 7:00 P.M.

Charlie Ganey led the assembly in the pledge of allegiance.

Robbins Flynn introduced the BOD, staff, and attending guests.

There were 61 members in attendance.

Boyd Pugh read the minutes from the 62nd annual meeting. Robert Robbins motioned to approve minutes as written. Charlie Ganey seconded this motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Jackson Laurence nominated himself for Place 3. Not sure who seconded this nomination.

Carla Coleman nominated herself for Place 3. Tracy Mosley seconded this nomination.

The candidates gave their nominations and introduced themselves.

The ballots were handed in and collected by staff members and given to Chris Kiley to count with Shawn Alves overseeing.

Robbins Flynn acknowledged Jimmy Ashcraft for the years he served on the Spanish Fort Water Board. He also acknowledged Mr. Joe Hamric for his serving on board and his passing last year.

There were 10 door prizes given away.

Mr. Kamassai complained about the water quality. He was told that it would be investigated and a staff member would get back in touch.

Charlie Ganey received a majority of the votes for place two and was re-elected for a five-year term.

James Boyd Pugh received a majority of the votes for place three and was re-elected for a five-year term.

Chris Kiley went over a brief overview of the audit. Jackson Laurence asked Chris a few questions about the audit.

The new logo was introduced.

Hank Bauer made several comments about the web and the contract with Mobile Area Water & Sewer.
